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Introduction

### Gus Tugendhat, Founder, Tussell

Scaleups are still not winning a big enough proportion of UK government contracts. But by harnessing transparency data we can at least monitor the situation and put in place reporting to improve it.

Scaleups can bring energy and innovation to the public sector. And winning a government contract confers a halo effect on the scaleup, giving it credibility and making it more visible to providers of finance in search of creditworthy SMEs in growth mode. So there is potential for a virtuous circle which should be promoted.

We are seeing a trend where more innovative local authorities are turning cost pressure to their advantage - to rethink, for example, the way that social care is being delivered. This can play to the advantage of scaleups offering more disruptive and flexible technology-based solutions to ageold problems.

#### The central versus local factor

What we currently observe is that central government mainly procures through OEMs and as such government needs to continue to encourage those OEMs to downstream buy from smaller scaleups in their supply chain - and measure that. On G-Cloud, however, SMEs won 45% of total contract value in 2018 - well above the government's 33% target. This demonstrates that, at least at the fore-front of public sector tech procurement, quality of the bid matters more than size of the company.



### **Foreword**

### Irene Graham, CEO, ScaleUp Institute

The public sector represents a huge and vital source of potential growth for scaleups, often providing a key "anchor customer" in their growth and development. Equally, buying from scaling companies represents a valuable opportunity for the public sector to support and engage with the UK's most innovative and productive companies. Fostering greater levels of public sector procurement from scaleups is a win-win.

The ScaleUp Institute has partnered with Tussell, a leading source of data on government contracts and tenders, to review scaleups' participation across the breadth of public sector procurement in the calendar

This second edition of our Index provides a comprehensive review of public procurement from scaleups in 2018, including a complete list of the 423 visible scaleups who supplied the public sector in 2018, and the local and national government bodies who procured from them.

Our ScaleUp Public Procurement Index matches information on visible scaleups, those scaleups required to file accounts at Companies House, with the Government's contract award data. This shows which

contracts and frameworks have been won by scaleup companies. It also shows which authorities most actively engaged with the scaleup ecosystem in 2018 and, just as importantly, where gaps and further opportunities remain. It provides a benchmark against which we can measure progress.

Our key findings from this analysis of 2018 include:

423 visible scaleups appeared on a total of 2,427 contracts issued by the wider public sector in 2018.

Visible scaleups won 1.2% of total public sector award value, meaning that both central and local government have more work to do to integrate scaleups into their supply chains.

Visible scaleups won over 2% of the total number of government contracts awarded in 2018.

Local Government buyers were the most important for visible scaleups in 2018: 38% of all contract awards issued to visible scaleups came from Local Government buyers, as well as 49% of the total value awarded.

Central Government awarded just 0.3% of the total value of their contracts to scaleups in 2018. There is much more for Central Government to do in order to engage with scaleups in the procurement process.

The top six regions in which visible scaleups won public sector contracts in 2018 were London, the South East, the North West, East of England, West Midlands and Scotland.

Outside of London, Manchester has the greatest concentration of contract-winning visible scaleups.

Older scaleup companies were more likely to win contracts. The average age of scaleup companies winning public sector contracts in 2018 was just under 28. Only one company incorporated in the last nine years won more than £50,000-worth of awards in 2018.

Northern Ireland-based IT company, Novosco, ranked as the top scaleup by total award value. It won the largest contract issued to a visible scaleup in 2018, which was from Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

28% of the scaleups that won public sector contracts in 2018 also raised funding in the year. This included the two most successful contract-winning scaleups in 2018, Novosco and Sevacare.

In 2018, 11 scaleups won more than £20m-worth of contracts by value:

Novosco: IT services, Belfast Sevacare: care services, Wolverhampton Buckingham Group Contracting: construction, Buckinghamshire

Human Support Group: care services, Manchester Castlerock Recruitment Group: healthcare recruitment, Merseyside

Aspens: contract catering, Worcestershire McLaughlin & Harvey: building and civil engineering contractors. Northern Ireland Westminster Homecare: care services, London

Beard: construction, Swindon **AVB Group:** advertising services, Belfast Axis Europe: property services, London

3% of the visible scaleups issued with public sector contracts were founded by women.

Construction, health and restaurant services, and health and social services, IT & telecoms, and business and finance services were the main sectors in which the public sector procured from scaleups. These five sectors accounted for 84% of all contracts won.

Six contracting authorities have issued 20 or more awards to visible scaleups.

The top buyers from scaleups were FCO Services and Opus LGSS People Solutions. FCO Services provides a range of integrated, secure services worldwide to the Foreign & Commonwealth Office and other UK government departments. Opus LGSS is a joint venture between Opus People Solutions and LGSS, established in January 2017 to meet the temporary and interim recruitment needs of Cambridgeshire County Council. Both these organisations issued a large amount of recruitment contracts in the business and finance services sector

The other top buyers from scaleups were the London Borough of Waltham Forest, Birmingham City Council, the University of the West of England, and the NHS Midlands & Lancashire Commissioning Support Unit.

The production of this Index would only be possible because of the transparency of data which is provided by the Government's publication of contract awards. Publishing such data helps to demystify procurement processes and enable scaleups to engage more easily.

However, we must continue to break down the barriers - strategic, cultural, procedural and structural - that the public sector has in place and which can make engagement hard for scaling businesses.

In our 2018 Scaleup Business Survey, access to UK markets (which included government procurement and collaboration) was highlighted by scaleup leaders as their second greatest barrier to growth.

Across the UK, we are regularly told by scaleups that the most important help they can receive is the ability to access buyers in a timely, consistent and efficient manner. They consistently cite the culture and procurement processes that go with trying to become a public sector supplier (or to a large corporate) as difficult and time consuming to navigate.

We hope that this Index will encourage public sector bodies to engage with, and purchase more from, scaling businesses.

Our thanks again go to our partners and Tussell. We will publish the third Public Procurement Index of Visible Scaleups in November 2019.

## We continue to recommend that both the public and private sector do more to engage with scaleups

Public bodies should use the inaugural Visible Scaleup Public Procurement Index to further improve their understanding and reporting on the procurement involving UK scaleups, including scaling businesses not yet visible at Companies House.

All public bodies should improve the way opportunities are promoted to scaleup companies by significantly raising the visibility of procurement champions and ensuring their roles have objectives and measurements. The Government should continue the evolution of Contracts Finder to become a smart platform and continue to develop more scaleup specific 'meet the buyer' events working with local areas and build on the current work underway as regards sandbox environments.

Large companies should report on the level of collaboration and procurement they source from scaleup companies.

Any procurement contracts with Government should require an increase in the amount of business undertaken with scaleups as part of the contracting process which should be monitored.



The gender imbalance of Scaleups that won contracts from the wider public sector in 2018 was pronounced. **Only 3%** of the visible Scaleups issued with public sector contracts were founded by women.

# Scaleup Procurement Index 2018

In 2018, 423 visible Scaleups won a total of 2,427 contracts from the wider public sector\*, including Central and Local Government, the NHS, and other organisations providing public services. This represents on average 5.7 contracts each, an increase on 2017 when 3.6 contracts were awarded per Scaleup.

#### Suppliers and Number of Contracts Won



Visible Scaleups won 1,079 contract awards worth a combined £895m during 2018, and were listed on 1,348 frameworks, with a potential value of up to £8bn.



\*AIM is a subsector of the London Stock Exchange. It allows smaller, less-viable companies to float shares with a more flexible regulatory system than is applicable to the main market.

This research is based on Tussell data, which has been openly published on Contracts Finder (CF) and Tenders Electronic Daily (TED). This includes all tenders and contract awards published by UK Contracting Authorities over a certain amount. Contracting Authorities required to publish on CF and TED include Central Government Departments, Local Authorities, Housing Associations, Higher Education bodies, Schools and arms lengths bodies. Further information on the data underlying this research is available upon request.

A scaleup is an enterprise with average annual growth in employees or turnover greater than 20 per cent per annum over a three year period, and with more than 10 employees at the beginning of the period. 'Visible' scaleups are those which meet the necessary size thresholds required to file turnover and employment figures at Companies House, filtering out subsidiaries, LLPs, charities, foreign headquartered businesses and acquired companies.

'Visible' Scaleups for this report are those who have won a public sector contract during 2018. Unless otherwise stated all data relates to 2018

Value refers to the lifetime contract value of awards and frameworks won in the period. The reported value of frameworks (essentially preferred supplier lists) is the maximum value that could be issued over the course of the agreement. We estimate framework value by dividing this maximum equally between all suppliers listed on the agreement.



Number of Scaleups as a proportion of total distinct suppliers awarded contracts







Value of awards won by SMEs as a proportion of total value awarded

Number of Large Awards Won




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### **Buyer Type**


Local Government buyers were the most important for Visible Scaleups in 2018. 38% of all contract awards issued to Visible Scaleups came from Local Government buyers, as well as 49% of the total value awarded. The average value of contracts issued to Scaleups by the NHS tended to be larger, whereas awards from Central Government tended to be smaller.

Value of Scaleup Awards by Buyer Type



Scaleups received both the greatest overall value and volume of awards from Local Government - 411 contracts worth a combined £434m. Central Government lagged far behind other parts of the public sector - awarding just £111m, or 0.3%, of the value of their contracts to Scaleups. Private Limited institutions, including Opus LGSS People Solutions and the Litmus Partnership, awarded the highest proportion of their contract value to visible Scaleups in 2018. These bodies awarded £92m, or 3.4%, of the total value of their awards to Scaleups.


Percentage of Award Value and Volume Issued to Scaleups

In 2018, 22% of all awards or frameworks issued to Scaleups were in the construction sector, the most of any sector in this period.


Number of Contracts Won by Scaleups by Sector



### Regions

The visible Scaleups that won public sector contracts in 2018 were largely concentrated in London and the South East. Outside of London, the next most successful visible Scaleups came from Manchester. 11 Mancunian Scaleups either won awards or were named on public sector frameworks in 2018.


Number of Scaleups winning Contracts by Region (Minimum 10 Visible Scaleups)



### Top Buyers - Awards

6 Contracting Authorities have issued 20 or more awards to visible Scaleups. These Contracting Authorities include Local Government, Central Government and NHS bodies. Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust issued £109m to Scaleups - the most of any public sector buyer. The three top public sector buyers all awarded just two contracts to Scaleups, showing that their contracts were far larger than those issued by other contracting authorities.

# Top Buyers x Top Sectors for Visible Scaleups

In 2018, the biggest buyers tended to concentrate the contracts they awarded to visible Scaleups across few sectors. The London Borough of Waltham Forest, Opus Lgss People Solutions and Birmingham Council all awarded the vast majority of their contracts to Scaleups in one to two key sectors. The award count from FCO Services and Opus LGSS People Solutions was so high on account of the large amount of recruitment contracts these buyers issued in the Business & Finance Services sector.



### Top Awards to Scaleups

Four of the largest awards issued to visible Scaleups were for Care and Support-related services. No one Scaleup was dominant amongst the top awards in 2018, with no supplier winning more than two of the largest contracts awarded.


Top 10 Awards issued to Scaleups by value



### Top Scaleups

IT management company, Novosco, was the Scaleup that won the most valuable awards in 2018. Excluding frameworks, they were issued with contracts with a combined lifetime value of £109m. This was due to the fact that Novosoco was the Scaleup awarded the largest contract in 2018 - a contract for outsourced IT services issued by Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Trust.

Top 20 Scaleups by Award Value




### Scaleups by Date of Incorporation

Of the 423 visible Scaleups that won public sector contracts in 2018, the oldest was John Graham Holdings. The construction group, first incorporated in 1788, was named on three public sector frameworks in 2018.

The average age of the Scaleups that won contracts from the public sector in 2018 was just under 28. Older Scaleups tended to dominate as a majority of the award value issued to Scaleups went to those incorporated between 1975 and 2000. Only 22% of the value awarded to Scaleups went to ones incorporated since 2000.


Top 5 Scaleups Incorporated Between 1975 and 2000



Scaleups incorporated after 2010 were not well represented amongst suppliers to the public sector. Behavioural Insights was the only Scaleup incorporated in the last 9 years that won over £50k worth of awards in 2018.

### Female-Founded Scaleups

Of the 423 visible Scaleups that won contract awards or were named on public sector frameworks in 2018, only 14 were founded by women. Similarly only 2% of the £895m worth of awards issued to Scaleups by the wider public sector went to ones founded by women.

87% of the award value issued to female-founded Scaleups in 2018 went to just one company, Potens. The health and support firm won the three largest contracts awarded to Scaleups that were founded by women. If it weren't for the success of Potens the gender imbalance of Scaleups winning public sector awards would be even more pronounced.



### Fundraising of Scaleups

118 of the visible Scaleups that raised funds in 2018 also won public sector contracts. The average amount of funds raised by these Scaleups was just over £10.5m.


In terms of winning contracts, the most successful firms that won fundraising were Novosco and Sevacare, who raised £600k and £5m in 2018 respectively. These two firms were also the two most successful Scaleups overall.

### Scaleups listed on AIM\* in 2018

Over the course of 2018, 24 Scaleups listed on AIM won a total of 90 contracts, awards and frameworks included. The awards had a combined lifetime value of £15m, and the frameworks had a potential value of up to £1bn.



Inspired Energy won the largest public sector awards of AIM-listed Scaleups in 2018, but GB Group and Idox won the most awards. These two companies were awarded 8 contracts each.



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## Conclusion



Public procurement is a vital market for scaleups, a valuable contract from a government department or local authority can be the vital customer a scaleup needs, acting as a catalyst for more growth opportunities. But of the £76.3 billion in contracts awarded by public sector bodies in 2018, only 1.2% was awarded to scaleups. This Index highlights the huge potential opportunities for scaleups, as well as the stark variation between localities and at a central level which can be improved upon.

Representing the whole of 2018, this Index is our benchmark by which we measure the progress of the Government's intent to do more with scaling firms. The policy announcements made in Spring 2018 reflected a range of the recommendations made by the ScaleUp Institute and Scaleup Taskforce to further move the dial including: expansion of Contracts Finder to include large corporate supplier subcontracting opportunities, and the development of procurement champions across all Government departments. The Index will be a tracker by which to measure whether the announcements actually deliver meaningful impact.

There still remains much more to be done if we are to address the significant scaleup procurement gap compared to larger businesses.

These are areas we wish to see further progress on:

- Contracts Finder being better used by the public sector, more user oriented, and better known among the scaleup business population.
- Procurement champions having clear objectives and measurements. They should work
  to a defined job description, with clear expectations and recognised outputs and be more
  visible in localities and sectors.
- OEMs and Tier 1 companies working with Government being further encouraged to work
  with scaleups in their supply chain. Productivity will be improved if interactions within
  supply chains can be enhanced and made more efficient.
- More 'meet the buyer' events being conducted with scaleup firms and Government departments, working closely with the emerging local scaleup programmes to make these more targeted.
- Qualifying thresholds should not be unnecessarily high as this can create significant hurdles for scaling firms.
- More timely advertising of procurement contracts.
- Informal notifications about upcoming tenders, in order to give scaleups time to prepare.
- Breaking larger opportunities into smaller packages, to enable scaleups to compete for a wider range of contracts where they would otherwise face capacity constraints.

Building an effective pipeline of procurement opportunities for scaleups will require a cultural change throughout the supply chain. We hope the Visible Scaleup Public Procurement Index kick starts this process and offers the opportunity for public and private sector organisations to become role models of working effectively with our fastest growing and most innovative business.
